



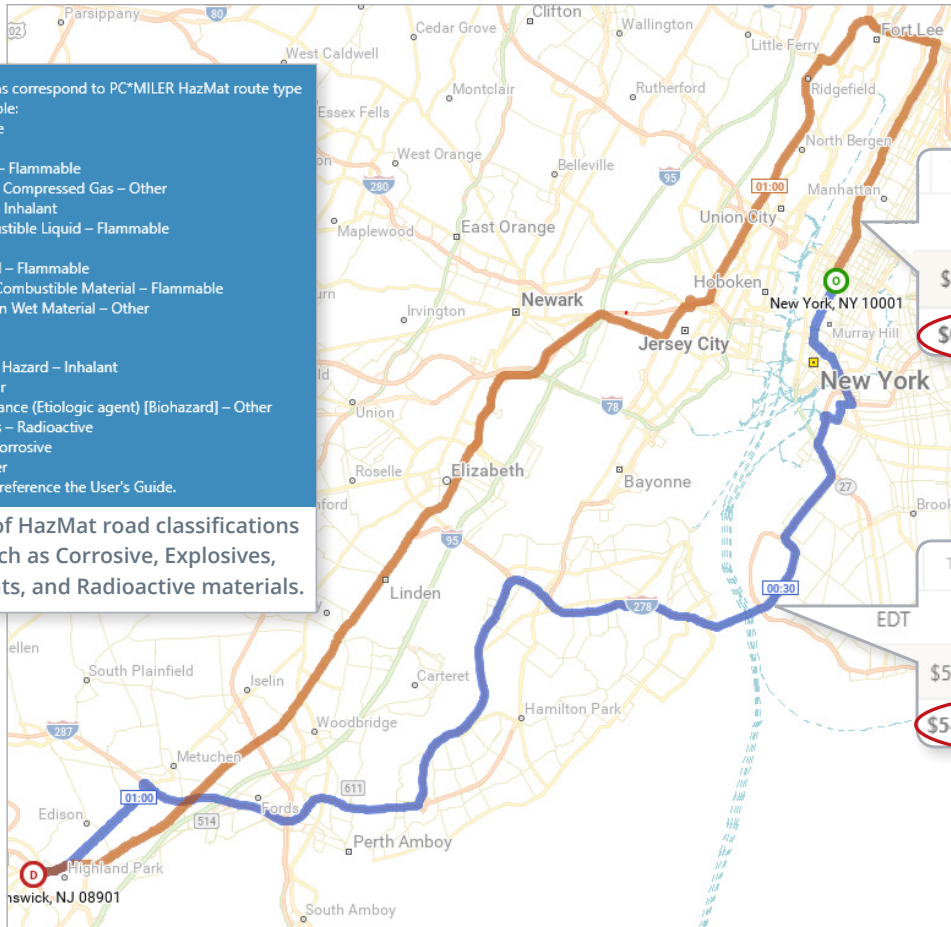
Ensure compliance and keep assets safe on legal roads when hauling hazardous materials

U.S. DOT hazmat classifications correspond to PC*MILER HazMat route type according to the following table:

- Class 1: Explosives – Explosive
- Class 2: Compressed Gases
 - 2.1: Flammable Gas – Flammable
 - 2.2: Non-Flammable Compressed Gas – Other
 - 2.3: Poisonous Gas – Inhalant
- Class 3: Flammable & Combustible Liquid – Flammable
- Class 4: Flammable Solids
 - 4.1: Flammable Solid – Flammable
 - 4.2: Spontaneously Combustible Material – Flammable
 - 4.3: Dangerous When Wet Material – Other
- Class 5: Oxidizers – Other
- Class 6: Poisons
 - 6.1: (part) Inhalation Hazard – Inhalant
 - 6.1: (balance) – Other
 - 6.2: Infectious Substance (Etiologic agent) [Biohazard] – Other
- Class 7: Radioactive Materials – Radioactive
- Class 8: Corrosive Liquids – Corrosive
- Class 9: Miscellaneous – Other
